Canyoneering will bring you to the Sand Flats Recreation Area to Ephedra's Grotto. Your guides take safety seriously and will make sure you are in good hands for the rappels, making this is a great tour for both experienced or inexperienced people. You will have a brief hike to the destination, have a couple of rappels into a stone room and then into a green canyon below. The tour then hikes along a stream for just over two miles to conclude the excursion.



Arches National Park Discovery Tours

Arches National Park is one of five National Parks in Utah. Each of these "Mighty Five" parks claims its own way of showcasing the magnificent geologic diversity of the Colorado Plateau. Arches National Park Tours showcase the more accessible of more than 2,000 arches. Driving and hiking through this Jurassic aged wonderland provides a glimpse back in time when gentle geologic forces from deep below the surface bulged upward to crack the surface sandstones into fins. Telling you the secret of how the fins of sandstone then became delicate ribbons of stone suspended in mid-air is a mystery best left to uncover on this tour!

Courthouse Loop | [Easy 7-10 miles](#) | Best for beginners and families. Kids as young as 5 years old are welcome so long as they are good using hand brakes and shifting gears. There is a whole network of trails in the area, so depending on the group dynamic and number of guides, there is a possibility of going on more moderate to intermediate trails.

Dead Horse Point | [Intermediate 9 mile loop](#) | For this scenic tour, your guide will check with guests to see if they are comfortable on singletrack, and some technical obstacles such as rock gardens, sharp turns, some downhill, roots, and varying terrain. If you have never been on a singletrack, Courthouse Loop is highly recommended. This excursion occurs at high elevation and can be physically intense.

Klondike Bluffs | [Intermediate 10-12 miles](#) | This is the most physical tour, and it is also technical. It is an out and back route on slickrock with a slight incline on the way up (physically challenging) and downhill on the way back (technical).
