Mount Rushmore & Flume Trail | Mt. Rushmore is the hot spot of the Black Hills and is a must see! Roam around the Great Faces and get to know the beauty and history of this National Monument. Partake in an exciting hike on the Flume Trail and witness the wildlife and foliage that it has to offer.

Mount Rushmore & Custer State Park | The morning will be spent near Sylvan Lake in Custer State Park. Pick your hike depending on your fitness level and interests. You will stop for a nice lunch followed by an afternoon spent at Mount Rushmore National Memorial in the beautiful Black Hills.

Badlands National Park | This National Park brings visitors from all around the world. Join a professional guide as you and your group explore the area on foot. Sharply eroded buttes, pinnacles and spires make up over 240,000 acres of this national gem; there is no other place like this!

Spearfish Canyon | There are multiple hiking options throughout this limestone gorge in the Black Hills. Spearfish Creek inhabits the canyon floor while many waterfalls flow into the creek from the towering red cliffs. Great site seeing and exploring in this area; do not miss it!

Devil's Tower National Monument | Located in Wyoming, but still part of the Black Hills, Devil's Tower stands at a whopping 1,200 feet! Considered a geological wonder to all, the tower and its surrounding areas are a hot spot for hikers and adventurer seekers alike.

Badlands | Travel to one of Western South Dakota's most unique landscapes. Enjoy a scenic drive through the Badlands and could add an optional hike. Enjoy lunch, and spend time exploring the famous Wall Drug, the ghost town of Scenic and the Minuteman Missile Site.

Spearfish Canyon | Enjoy a scenic drive beautiful Spearfish Canyon. Take in Bridal Veil Falls and Roughlock Falls while you are in the canyon. Visit historic Deadwood and learn of the incredible history that inspired the hit television show Deadwood. Have a chance to explore Mt. Moriah Cemetery, and Adams Museum. Lunch will be provided at a location of your choosing.

Black Hills Monument | Travel to Mount Rushmore. You will spend time hiking around the monument. Next, you will travel to Crazy Horse Memorial, learning the importance and history of Crazy Horse. Finally, you will get an opportunity to explore beautiful Custer State Park. You will be able to see wildlife at an incredibly, close proximity and enjoy the local flora. In each of these locations, you will gain unique and rare insight into the history of the Black Hills.

Mount Rushmore & Iron Mountain Road | Start your excursion at Mount Rushmore; walk below George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Theodore Roosevelt, and Abraham Lincoln on the Presidential Trail. Then, take a scenic drive along Iron Mountain Road. Experience the switchbacks & tunnels, watching for Monument along the way.

Crazy Horse & Iron Mountain Road | Visit Crazy Horse, a memorial of the Lakota leader; experience culture, tradition of the North American Indians at this unique, 563' tall carving. Take a scenic drive along Iron Mountain Road along the switchbacks & tunnels, watching for Monument along the way.

Needles Highway & Sylvan Lake | Let your guide do all the driving and take in the sights together as you ride along Needles Highway, winding through pine and spruce forests and squeezing through Iron Creek Tunnel and Needles Eye Tunnel. This route wouldn't be complete without a stop at Sylvan Lake, considered the crown jewel of Custer State Park.

Custer State Park Wildlife Loop | Ride through Custer State Park's Wildlife Loop. Odds are high of sighting bison, pronghorn, whitetail deer, elk, mule deer, prairie dogs, & more in the grasslands. Watch for eagles and hawks in the pine-speckled hills.
