- **Booking Fee:** All adventures have a 10% booking fee built in. This is included in all provided prices and quotes.
- Arrival/Departure Days: Adventures can be requested for your day of arrival or departure. However, tours cannot be refunded or rescheduled due to unexpected travel delays; allow adequate time to arrive prior to the start of your tour. If you have a tour for the day of departure, you must check out of your tent prior to your excursion.
- **Guide Gratuity:** Guide gratuity is not included unless otherwise noted. Guides do everything within their means to ensure you have a wonderful experience and recognizing that with a cash tip is encouraged. A general guideline for tipping is 15% or more.
- **Pets:** While Under Canvas is pet friendly, dogs are not allowed to join guests on tours and excursions. Please make arrangements prior to your adventure, as dogs cannot be left at camp unattended.
