## Group Hummer Safari - Sunset (3 hours)

The Sunset Hummer Safari departs each evening just before sunset from the Moab Adventure Center. Within minutes of departure you'll be scaling one of Moab's famous redrock fins on your way to an area known as "Hell's Revenge." Weave in and out of rock canyons, feel the power and confidence of the Hummer as it climbs steep sandstone hills. While on the trip, learn about the geology of the area, along with the history of the Canyonlands area. Midway through the trip, have an unforgettable experience as you ascend to the summit of a captivating overlook. As you head back on the trail, stop to see ancient dinosaur tracks embedded in the rock surface. This is where you will relax, take pictures, and enjoy a snack or two while the desert sun paints the evening sky. End your trip by climbing aboard the Hummer one last time as you head back to Moab.

## Group Arches National Park Discovery Tour (4 hours)

Arches National Park is one of five National Parks in Utah. Each of these "Mighty Five" parks claims its own way of showcasing the magnificent geologic diversity of the Colorado Plateau. Arches National Park Tours showcase the more accessible of more than 2,000 arches - the highest concentration of arches on the planet. Driving and hiking through this Jurassic aged wonderland provides a glimpse back in time when gentle geologic forces from deep below the surface bulged upward to crack the surface sandstones into fins. Telling you the secret of how these fins of sandstone then became delicate ribbons of stone suspended in mid-air is a mystery we will leave for the tour. Step right this way!

Sit back and take in the astounding views as a professional guide takes you through the park. From the vehicle, you'll see views of famous Balanced Rock, Courthouse Towers, La Sal Mountains, Petrified Dunes, and Panorama Point. You'll also enjoy short guided walks to the North and South Window Arches, Turret Arch, as well as the legendary Delicate Arch Overlook. The views only get better as the setting sun paints the surrounding sandstone monoliths and La Sal Mountains spectacular shades of color.

This half-day canyon tour takes us across ancient sand dunes and down into a lush canyon with flowing water via two spectacular rappels, each around 100 feet in length. The first rappel deposits us into the route's namesake – the Medieval Chamber – a deep, dark hallway that cannot be accessed without the use of ropes. From there, we continue to our second rappel, next to one of Moab's largest natural bridges – Morning Glory Bridge. With expert guidance, this excellent Moab canyoneering route is one of the best beginner and family friendly tours around.

Zig Zag Canyon combines adventurous hiking over ancient sand dunes with big views and fun obstacles, all leading up to a descent into a beautiful canyon via Moab's longest guided rappel! This adventures is a winding, circuitous loop hike that has us gaining and losing several hundred feet of elevation over three miles of exploration. We travel through adventurous and secluded terrain that has not been seen by many. We hike, scramble, climb and scoot our way over and through obstacles. After two short rappels, we'll end the day with a spectacular 220' rappel that is sure to leave you feeling proud, accomplished, and full of bragging rights!

Granary Canyon showcases seculded wilderness, fantastic rappels and an abundance of natural arches!

Very few day hikes contain as many exquisite natural arches as the journey through Granary Canyon, and what a journey it is! Six fantastic rappels and a lot of tricky scrambling are encountered within the depths of this remote canyon, which houses at least seven major arches and scores of smaller ones. Over the course of this one-way, 6 mile hike, we'll descend over 2,000 feet! Despite the day's numerous rappels, this hike is within reason for adventurous first-time rappellers.
