The Beginner Day Hike is a hiking & sightseeing tour that is great for first time Grand Canyon hikers, offering views of the Canyon from the inside and out! This is a well-maintained trail known as a corridor trail, which means it is a main route for mules and people to the bottom of Grand Canyon. Ooh, Ahh Point is typically where you'll pause for a picnic lunch before heading back above the Rim. Then, you'll spend your afternoon sightseeing around the Grand Canyon's South Rim before heading back to Under Canvas.

This Grand Canyon bike tour leaves right from the Village and follows the newest greenway section eastward to Yaki Point. A half-mile into the tour, you will emerge into a clearing that offers your first spectacular view of the Grand Canyon. From there, the path winds like a river along the Rim almost all the way to the Yaki Point lookout. Your guide will take you through a colorful history of geology, plant life and human history along the way. They will also introduce you to some of Grand Canyon's wildlife which is commonly seen in this area.
