Description Under Canvas Columbia River Gorge, situated in a pristine valley surrounded by pine and oak forests and lush mountain peaks, features breathtaking views of Mount Hood and the White Salmon Valley. The camp is conveniently located in the region's spectacular wine country, a beautifully scenic one-hour drive from Portland, Oregon. Hood River, Oregon, and White Salmon, Washington—two quintessential Pacific Northwest towns known for their endless outdoor adventures—are less than a half-hour drive and feature lively breweries, wineries and rich cultural experiences. Under Canvas Columbia River Gorge is thoughtfully designed and outfitted to reflect the rich textures and natural hues of the Pacific Coast region. It features contemporary West Elm furniture, artwork from local artists, books and games from local makers, and creative food and beverage options that reflect the unique flavors of the Northwest.

The 120-acre property, located in Washington's beautiful White Salmon River Valley, is ideally situated along the majestic Columbia River Gorge, a jaw-dropping canyon carved by the Columbia River featuring towering cliffs and cascading waterfalls. The camp is surrounded by forested hillsides, with snowcapped mountains in the distance and spectacular views in every direction. Under Canvas Columbia River Gorge is a 45-minute drive from Oregon's Mount Hood and approximately an hour and 15 minutes to Portland International Airport. It is less than 15 miles from the town of White Salmon, Washington, and 25 miles from Mount Hood, Oregon, two charming towns in the heart of the Columbia River Gorge's wine country known for their variety outdoor activities, coffee shops and bakeries, breweries and wine tastings, and breathtaking views.

Tents

Under Canvas Columbia River Gorge offers 50 upscale, safari-inspired canvas tents, each with a king-size bed, plush linens, a gas fireplace, private elevated deck, battery-operated lanterns and fans, and an ensuite bathroom. The camp's seven different tent types including the following:

Mount Hood Suite Tent

Ideal for families or groups, the Mount Hood Suite Tent features two tents adjoined by a private deck with its own private firepit and outdoor area. Each of the two tents has a king-size bed, gas fireplace, and ensuite bathroom with pull-chain shower, sink, flushing toilet, and EO bath products. In addition, one of the tents features a sitting area with queen-size pull-out sofa bed.

Suite Tent

The Suite Tent features a king-size bed and a lounge area with queen-size pull-out sofa bed. The private ensuite bathroom includes a pull-chain shower, sink, flushing toilet, and EO bath products. A gas fireplace keeps the tent warm at night and the private deck is ideal for stargazing.

Suite with Adjacent Kids Tent

The Suite with Kids Tent offers all the amenities of our traditional Suite Tent, plus a private, adjacent tent for the kids. The spacious, high-ceiling Kids Tent features two twin beds, two cozy West Elm bean bag chairs, a Pottery Barn nightlight and private porch.

Sleeps: 6 (up to 4 adults + 2 kids)

Bathroom: Private

Stargazer Tent

The Stargazer Tent boasts its own viewing window above the king-size bed to stargaze at night. The private ensuite bathroom includes a pull-chain shower, sink, flushing toilet, and EO bath products. A gas fireplace keeps the tent warm at night and a private deck allows you to enjoy the outdoors in solitude.

Stargazer with Adjacent Kids Tent

The Stargazer with Kids Tent offers all the amenities of the traditional Stargazer Tent, plus a private adjacent tent for the kids. The spacious, high-ceiling Kids Tent features two twin beds, two cozy West Elm bean bag chairs, a Pottery Barn nightlight and private porch.

Sleeps: 4 (2 adults + 2 kids)

Deluxe Tent

The Deluxe Tent features a king-size bed and private ensuite bathroom with a pull-chain shower, sink, flushing toilet, and EO bath products. A gas fireplace

keeps the tent warm at night and a private deck allows guests to enjoy the star-filled night skies.

Deluxe with Adjacent Kids Tent

Dining

The camp's onsite dining concept, Embers, serves as a communal hub for cafe-style dining and gathering with friends and family. The seasonal menu features fresh and healthy dishes including salads, charcuterie, fresh trout, burgers, and vegan and vegetarian dishes. It also features West Coast-inspired items such as Columbia River salmon and other seafood from Portland and Seattle, as well as a selection of curated wines and craft beers from the area. Mindful Approach

At Under Canvas, our mission is to inspire connections with extraordinary places, people, and the planet by enhancing access to the outdoors. We uphold that mission with our *Mindful Approach*, which comes to life through everything we do: from the design choices we make, to the experiences we curate for our guests, to the operational initiatives that we implement to help protect and preserve the natural environment.

- **Thoughtful Innovation:** As pioneers in the outdoor hospitality space, we remain committed to employing thoughtful, low-impact development and operations initiatives across our destinations. We focus on intentionally integrating our camps into the surrounding natural environment and prioritize recycling, solar power, and carbon offset practices whenever possible.
- **Resource Conservation:** We conserve water and energy with pull-chain showers, low-flow toilets, faucets that automatically shut off, low-level lighting, and a towel-reuse program. Accordingly, our

camps use significantly less water and energy than a hotel of similar size. Rechargeable USB battery packs are used in guest tents, and electric vehicle charging stations are available at select locations for guests to use throughout their stay.

- **International DarkSky Principles:** We work with DarkSky International to enhance our sky quality, minimize our lighting impact, and educate others on the importance of protecting and preserving the night sky. Under Canvas camps adhere to DarkSky principles, and five are officially DarkSky-certified, making them the first DarkSky-certified resorts in the world.
- **Land Conservation:** Under Canvas destinations are designed to minimize disturbance and maximize open space. As such, we maintain dedicated, undisturbed green spaces.
- **In Good Company:** We partner with brands that align with our mission and values—and share the same care for our planet. For example, plant-based EO[®] bath products are made in a zero-waste facility, West Elm furnishings support sustainable initiatives, and lululemon is committed to 100% renewable electricity for their owned and operated facilities.
- **Unplug and Recharge:** Wi-fi is intentionally not offered to our guests so that they can disconnect from technology and reconnect with others.

At Under Canvas Columbia River Gorge, we have implemented developmental and operational initiatives that help protect the White Salmon Wild and Scenic River that crosses our property and preserve the oak habitat of the Western grey squirrel that lives in the area. We have also partnered with the Washington Department of Natural Resources to remove trees on property, in order to improve forest health and mitigate fire risk and have donated a portion of those trees to the protection of fish habitat in the area.
