

Group Guided Hiking - Avalanche Lake (8 hours)

The Trail of the Cedars is one of the most popular hikes in Glacier National Park. Starting at the lush trailhead, the boardwalk winds through an ancient forest of western red cedars and hemlocks, leading to the Avalanche Lake trail where hikers can marvel at avalanche blowdown, massive glacial features, and a glacier-fed cirque basin.
