- **Cancellation Policy:** Adventures may be cancelled until 30 days prior for a 100% refund. Within 30 days, all adventures are non-refundable, non-modifiable, and non-transferable. If the guide cancels your trip (due to adverse weather, unsafe conditions, etc.), you will receive a full refund. Rainy, cloudy, or windy weather does not mean a trip will be cancelled. Adventures are arranged with third-party outfitters. This policy applies only to the tours that Under Canvas has arranged on your behalf.

- **Payment:** If an activity is available, payment will be processed to your card on file. Advanced booking is encouraged.
