Description

Under Canvas White Mountains is set on 86 scenic acres with breathtaking views of Mount Washington and the Presidential Range, surrounded by rolling meadows, lush forests and orchards. The upscale, outdoor hospitality destination offers travelers a one-of-a-kind outdoor experience in New England's natural beauty, from summit views to scenic drives and endless trails.

Location

Located on the quieter western side of the White Mountains, Under Canvas White Mountains offers easy access to serene outdoor recreation, scenic mountain vistas, forested hiking trails, and charming local treasures—from orchard-fresh apples to rich maple syrup, with convenient access to White Mountain National Forest—one of the most visited national forests in the U.S. Within a short drive, guests can explore Franconia Notch State Park, the Kancamagus Highway, and the iconic Mount Washington Cog Railway. The camp is also just a short distance from charming gateway towns like Littleton, Bethlehem, and Lancaster. From Appalachian Trail hikes and Connecticut River boating to mountain and gravel biking, and vibrant fall foliage viewing, Under Canvas White Mountains is the perfect basecamp for seasonal outdoor adventure. Guests can also experience the area's rich rural charm, from covered bridges and sugar shacks to cideries and ski resorts transformed into summer recreation hubs.

Tents

Under Canvas White Mountains features 45 tents with four different style options including:

Deluxe Tent

The Deluxe Tent boasts a plush king-size bed with an ensuite bathroom featuring a pull-chain shower with hot water, sink and flushing toilet. Lounge by day - or night - on your private deck before retreating to your upscale tent with a wood-burning stove for in-tent heating.

- shut off, low-level lighting, and a towel-reuse program. Accordingly, our camps use significantly less water and energy than a hotel of similar size. Rechargeable USB battery packs are placed in guest tents to use throughout their stay.
- International DarkSky principles: We work with DarkSky
 International to enhance our sky quality, minimize our lighting
 impact, and educate others on the importance of protecting and
 preserving the night sky. All of our camps adhere to DarkSky
 principles, and five are officially DarkSky-certified—making them
 the first DarkSky-certified lodging properties in the world."
- Land Conservation: Under Canvas destinations are designed to minimize disturbance and maximize open space. As such, we maintain dedicated, undisturbed green spaces at each camp.
- In Good Company: We partner with brands that align with our mission and values—and share the same care for our planet. For example, plant-based EO ® bath products are made in a zero-waste facility, West Elm furnishings support sustainable initiatives, and lululemon is committed to 100% renewable electricity for their owned and operated facilities.
- Unplug and Recharge: Wi-fi is intentionally not offered to our guests so that they can disconnect from technology and reconnect with others.
