Description

Set upon 750 acres of beautiful, secluded high mountain plains, Under Canvas Bryce Canyon boasts expansive views of John's Valley – including Mount Dutton and Adams Head to the west and Utah's red rocks to the east. Ideally positioned to provide unparalleled access to Utah's national parks and landscapes, the upscale outdoor hospitality brand's fourth Utah location provides the perfect opportunity to explore the wonder of the American Southwest via the Grand Circle Road Trip. Running on solar power, Under Canvas Bryce Canyon offers safari-style canvas tents on elevated decks with private ensuite bathrooms surrounded by a juniper forest, at 7,600 feet in elevation, with incredible valley views as far as the eye can see. The new camp is conveniently located near the area's hoodoos and Dixie National Forestland and is central to multiple national parks and monuments.

Location

Located just 15 minutes from the entrance to Bryce Canyon National Park, this high-alpine setting provides effortless access to the park's iconic crimson hoodoos and dramatic amphitheaters. The area is perfectly positioned for exploring the 38-mile scenic drive, where winding roads lead to breathtaking overlooks and sun-drenched vistas along the high-desert plateau. Surrounded by the tranquility of the Dixie National Forest, the location balances rugged exploration with the quiet, expansive beauty and unique geological formations of Southern Utah.

As one of the world's first DarkSky Certified resorts, Under Canvas Bryce Canyon focuses on restoring the nighttime environment through advocacy, dedicated initiatives, donations to DarkSky International, and local volunteer efforts that help preserve the outdoor places where guests and communities live, work, and explore. Guests can enjoy an immersive stargazing escape with Stargazer Tents, celestial-inspired dining, and star parties, plus easy access to Bryce Canyon National Park, a designated DarkSky Park.

Under Canvas Bryce Canyon features 50 tents with seven different tent options including:

### Deluxe

The Deluxe Tent boasts a plush king-size bed with an ensuite bathroom featuring a pull-chain shower with hot water, sink and flushing toilet. A wood-burning stove keeps the tent warm at night and a private deck allows you to enjoy the night stars.

## Mindful Approach

At Under Canvas, our mission is to inspire connections with extraordinary places, people, and the planet by enhancing access to the outdoors. We uphold that mission with our *Mindful Approach*, which comes to life through everything we do: from the design choices we make, to the experiences we curate for our guests, to the operational initiatives that we implement to help protect and preserve the natural environment.

- Thoughtful Innovation: As pioneers in the outdoor hospitality space, we remain committed to employing thoughtful, low-impact development and operations initiatives across our destinations. We focus on intentionally integrating our camps into the surrounding natural environment and prioritize recycling, solar power, and carbon offset practices whenever possible.
- Resource Conservation: We conserve water and energy with pull-chain showers, low-flow toilets, faucets that automatically shut off, low-level lighting, and a towel-reuse program. Accordingly, our camps use significantly less water and energy than a hotel of similar size. Rechargeable USB battery packs are used in guest tents, and electric vehicle charging stations are available at select locations for guests to use throughout their stay.
- International DarkSky principles: We work with DarkSky International to enhance our sky quality, minimize our lighting impact, and educate others on the importance of protecting and preserving the night sky. All of our camps adhere to DarkSky principles, and five are officially DarkSky-certified—making them the first DarkSky-certified lodging properties in the world."
- Land Conservation: Under Canvas destinations are designed to minimize disturbance and maximize open space. As such, we maintain dedicated, undisturbed green spaces at each camp.
- In Good Company: We partner with brands that align with our mission and values—and share the same care for our planet. For example, plant-based EO® bath products are made in a zero-waste facility, West Elm furnishings support sustainable initiatives, and lululemon is committed to 100% renewable electricity for their owned and operated facilities.
- Unplug and Recharge: Wi-fi is intentionally not offered to our guests so that they can disconnect from technology and reconnect with others.
