Description

Under Canvas Columbia River Gorge opened on May 29, 2025 as the brand's first camp in the Pacific Northwest. The camp's design thoughtfully reflects the rich textures and natural hues of the Pacific Coast region, and food and beverage offerings include local favorites like Columbia River salmon and other fresh seafood from Portland and Seattle, as well as a selection of curated wines and craft beers from the area. Under Canvas' Adventure Concierge can assist guests in curating and booking local experiences – from rafting and paddleboarding to guided hiking, mountain biking, and more. Guests can return to their upscale, safari-inspired canvas tents on elevated private decks in the evening, furnished with plush king-size bed, luxe linens, USB charging packs, bedside lanterns, gas fireplace and ensuite bathroom that features a hot pull-chain shower, sink and flushing toilet.

Location

Under Canvas Columbia River Gorge is set on a stunningly beautiful 120-acre property perched along the majestic Columbia River Gorge in Washington's White Salmon River Valley, a region known for its towering peaks, famed waterfalls and lush forests, offering endless opportunities for outdoor adventures.

Camps

The Columbia River Gorge site features 50 tents with seven different tent options:

Deluxe Tent

The Deluxe Tent boasts a plush king-size bed with an ensuite bathroom featuring a pull-chain shower with hot water, sink and flushing toilet. A wood-burning stove keeps the tent warm at night and a private deck allows you to enjoy the night stars.

- Resource Conservation: We conserve water and energy with pull-chain showers, low-flow toilets, faucets that automatically shut off, low-level lighting, and a towel-reuse program. Accordingly, our camps use significantly less water and energy than a hotel of similar

size. Rechargeable USB battery packs are used in guest tents, and electric vehicle charging stations are available at select locations for guests to use throughout their stay.

- International DarkSky principles: We work with DarkSky International to enhance our sky quality, minimize our lighting impact, and educate others on the importance of protecting and preserving the night sky. All of our camps adhere to DarkSky principles, and five are officially DarkSky-certified—making them the first DarkSky-certified lodging properties in the world."
- Land Conservation: Under Canvas destinations are designed to minimize disturbance and maximize open space. As such, we maintain dedicated, undisturbed green spaces at each camp.
- In Good Company: We partner with brands that align with our mission and values—and share the same care for our planet. For example, plant-based EO® bath products are made in a zero-waste facility, West Elm furnishings support sustainable initiatives, and lululemon is committed to 100% renewable electricity for their owned and operated facilities.
- Unplug and Recharge: Wi-fi is intentionally not offered to our guests so that they can disconnect from technology and reconnect with others.
