Description

Located on 85 acres of serene mountainside forest surrounded by mature, Yosemite-native trees sits Under Canvas Yosemite, the brand's 13th camp to open and first-ever California location. Under Canvas Yosemite offers close proximity to trailheads, the family-friendly Rainbow Pool natural swimming hole and a YARTS (Yosemite Area Regional Transportation System) stop directly across from the camp's entrance, offering car-free access into the national park multiple times each day.

Location

Under Canvas Yosemite is located just 10 minutes from the west entrance of Yosemite National Park at Big Oak Flat Information Station. As California's most-visited national park, located in the majestic Sierra Nevada Mountains, Yosemite National Park is known for its multiple waterfalls, including Yosemite Falls, one of the tallest waterfalls in the country; giant sequoia groves; the sheer granite cliffs of El Capitan and Half Dome; two remaining glaciers, and more. Under Canvas' Adventure Concierge can assist guests in booking in-park and local experiences—from rafting, rock climbing and fly fishing, to guided hiking, driving tours, photography classes and more—and an on-site Guest Experience Coordinator will be available to recommend favorite local hikes and must-see attractions.

Rechargeable USB battery packs are used in guest tents, and electric vehicle charging stations are available at select locations for guests to use throughout their stay. ● International DarkSky principles: We work with DarkSky International to enhance our sky quality, minimize our lighting impact, and educate others on the importance of protecting and preserving the night sky. All of our camps adhere to DarkSky principles, and six are officially DarkSky-certified—making them the first DarkSky-certified lodging properties in the world." ● Land Conservation: Under Canvas destinations are designed to minimize disturbance and maximize open space. As such, we maintain dedicated, undisturbed green spaces at each camp. ● In Good Company: We partner with brands that align with our mission and values—and share the same care for our planet. For

example, plant-based EO ® bath products are made in a zero-waste facility, West Elm furnishings support sustainable initiatives, and lululemon is committed to 100% renewable electricity for their owned and operated facilities.
